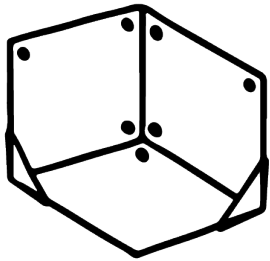

ROOM


Is it a room for a dolls house?

Materials


- Scissors
- Pencil
- Sturdy cardboard
- Hole punch
- 3 x 3D corner connectors
(See 'Build your basics')
- 7 x surfboard or star connectors
(See 'Build your basics')
- Things to decorate with

What to do


1 Before you begin, make some star or surfboard connectors. You'll find the instructions under 'Build your basics'.




2 Cut three squares out of cardboard. We've used 20 cm x 20cm, but you can make it smaller or bigger. As long as they're all the same.




3 If you haven't already, make three 3D corner connectors. Put the 3D connector on the corner of each square, and mark where the hole should go.




4 Use a hole punch or a pencil to make the holes. (If you use a pencil, put something soft like a cloth or folded tissue behind the card.)




5 Bring your room to life! Use markers, paints, and glue on decorations like buttons, ribbons, tin foil and cotton wool for details. Two squares are walls, one is the floor.



6 Use surfboard or star connectors to attach one wall of your room to a 3D corner. Add a 3D corner to the other side.



7 Add the other wall and the floor using your connectors. Keep adding on rooms to make an incredible house!
