ANIMALS

They say elephants never forget - so here's hoping you remember this simple way to design and make any animal you want!

Materials



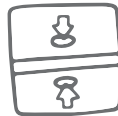
Cereal Box



Scissors



Pencil



Star or surfboard connectors



Soft cloth



Things to decorate with

What to do

1 Before you get started, you'll need to make some star or surfboard connectors. You'll find them under 'Build your basics'.

Flatten out your cereal box.

2 Draw all the different parts of your animal. Think: body, head, legs, tail, wings. This elephant needs a trunk, too.

3 Cut roughly around each piece to separate them. Then trim carefully up to the line.

4 Work out how all the parts go together. They should overlap where you want to join them.

5 Put a soft cloth, folded tissue or some putty under each piece, and use a pencil to make a hole where you want to connect them. Anywhere you want to join two pieces, each should have a hole.

6 To connect two pieces, line up the holes, and push a connector through. Make sure surfboard connectors are unfolded, and star connector tabs are pushed flat.

7 Once it's all together you're ready to decorate.

Experiment with changing shapes, sizes, patterns and colours every time you make one. You can invent new animals too!
